In December 2025, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) approved Alliant Energy's 2026 rate review and fuel cost plan (Docket 6680-UR-125). The updated electric rates and fuel cost plan effective January 1, 2026, are below.

Natural gas rates for residential customers

In December 2025, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) approved new natural gas base rates effective January 1, 2026 (Docket 6680-UR-125). The average impact of the adjustment on residential customer bills is an increase of approximately 3% or \$2.12 per month.¹

Your bill shows separate charges for distribution (what we charge for delivering natural gas) and gas supply (what we pay to acquire natural gas). The gas supply base rate changes monthly with the gas supply market adjustment the PSCW approves.
