Getting started


You can start service online.

Once enrolled in My Account, text PAY to 255255.

Save energy, money – and the planet

You pay for electricity based on how much you use. Small changes can make a big difference.

- 1. Use LED light bulbs instead of incandescent bulbs. According to energy.gov, the average household saves about \$225 per year in energy costs when they use LEDs. LEDs last a long time, so don't forget to take them with you when you leave!
- 2. Buy a smart power strip to automatically cut power to devices when not in use.
- 3. Adjust your thermostat by 10 degrees if you're going out of town for the weekend.

Power outages

They don't happen often. If you ever do find yourself in the dark, here's what to know:

- Your meter reports power outages automatically, so you don't have to.
- Check the outage map to see when we expect your power will be back on at alliantenergy.com/outage.
