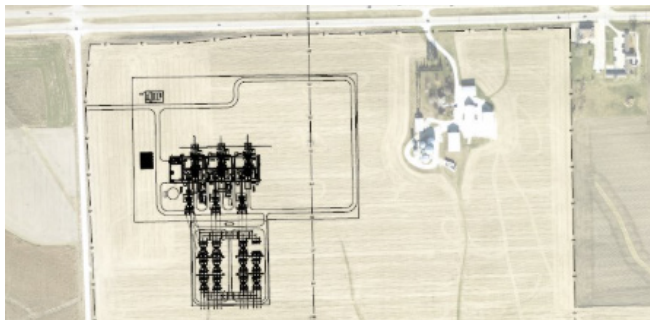


Alliant Energy's Morgan Valley Energy Center

We propose to develop Morgan Valley Energy Center as part of our commitment to deliver reliable, cost-effective energy to communities and customers across Iowa. The project supports grid reliability and our balanced energy portfolio comprised of renewable and traditional resources working together to ensure the lights stay on during times of peak demand and extreme weather.

What is the Morgan Valley Energy Center?

We propose to construct the project in unincorporated Linn County, south of Highway 30 near Linn Benton Road. We expect it to include three combustion turbine (CT) generators, each with approximately 240 megawatts of capacity.



Combustion turbines:

- Respond quickly when electricity demand is high.
- Operate when other resources are limited.
- Support a balanced and resilient energy system.

How combustion turbines support reliability

Combustion turbine facilities are an important complement to renewable energy resources and are critical to our balanced energy mix. They're:

- Flexible and dispatchable, able to start quickly when needed.
- Capable of operating 24/7 during critical periods.
- Designed for low water use compared to traditional generation.

Environmental review

Environmental protections are a key part of the project design and review process.

- We anticipate no impact to wetland, endangered species or cultural resources impacts.
- Linn County Public Health and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources will evaluate air emissions to ensure protection of public health.
- The facility will meet or exceed all local, state and federal environmental requirements.

Permitting: 2026–2027 • Construction: 2027–2030 • Operation: 2030

The schedule above reflects the timeline as of March 2026 and is subject to change.
